In addition to the use of knowledge organisers, students can carry out extra research.

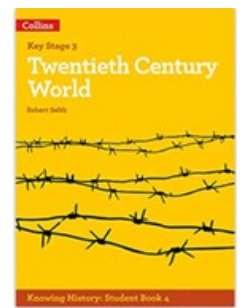
