



Dear Parent/Carer,

Following on from the letter sent to you earlier this week, I wanted to take this opportunity to introduce myself to you as the new Headteacher here at Buile Hill Academy, Having been appointed to the role of Deputy Headteacher in June 2021. I have been part of our school community here at Buile Hill for two years, having previously been a Deputy Headteacher in South East London, and bring with me experience of improving schools in similar contexts for over 10 years now.
